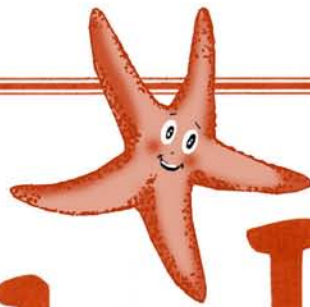

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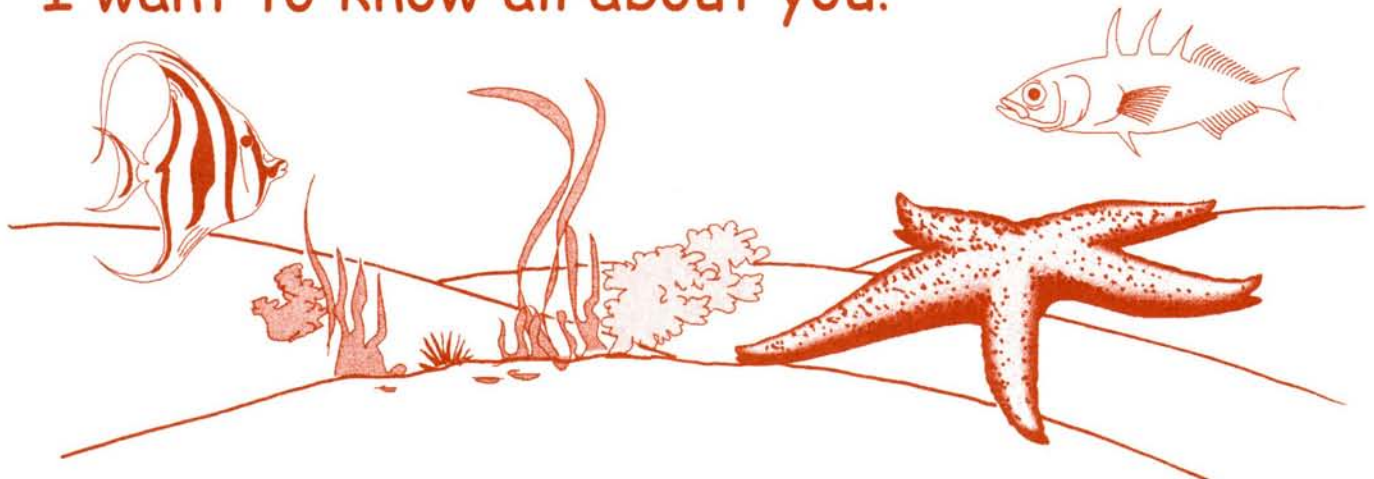
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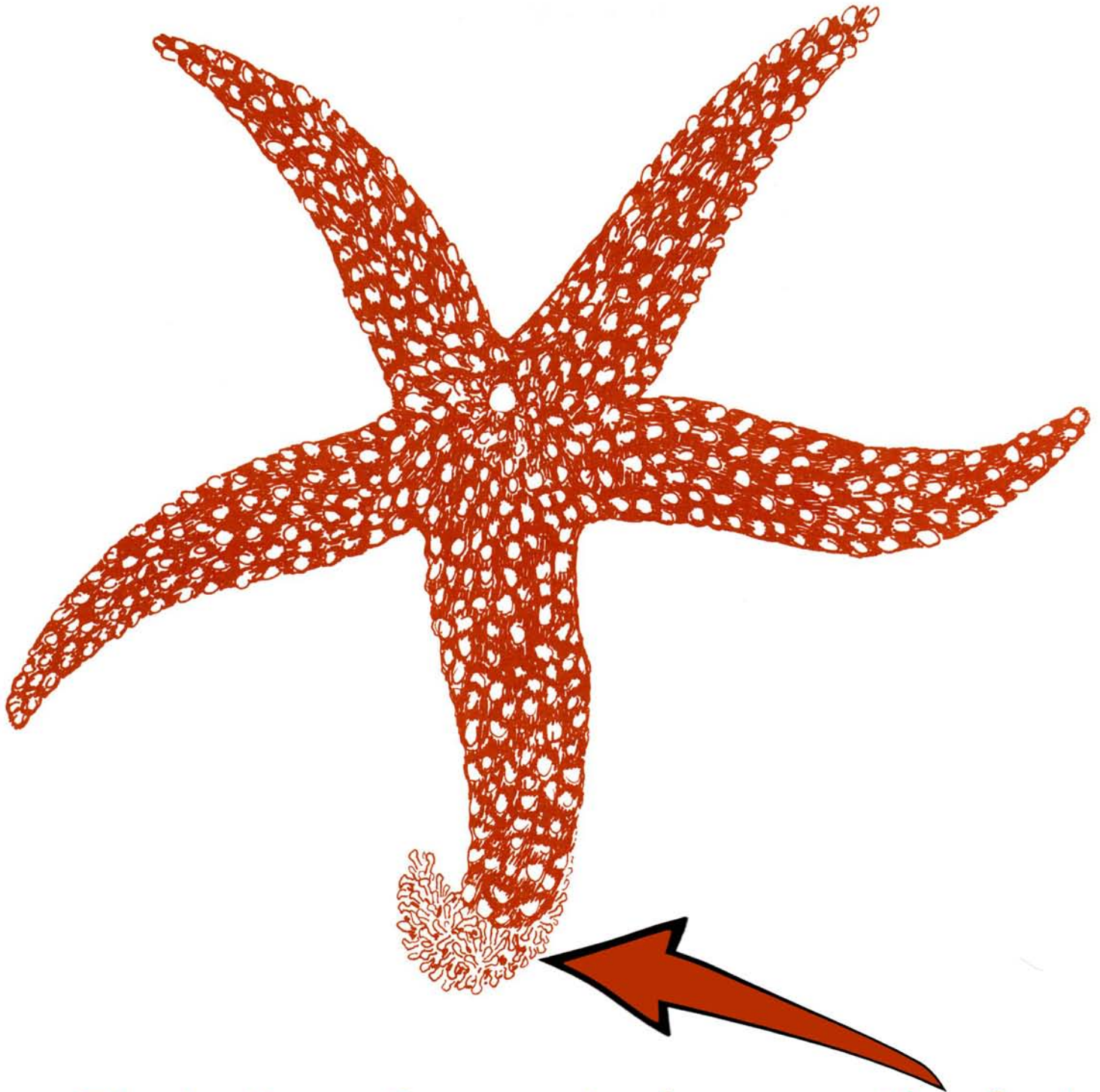
TWINKLE, TWINKLE LITTLE SEA STAR

I want to know all about you!



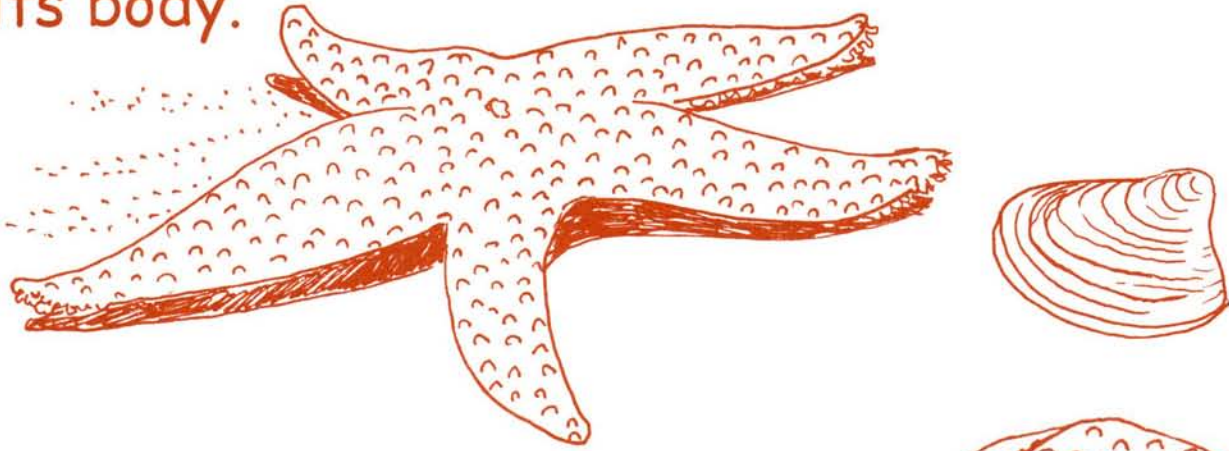
All sea stars live in the sea. Most have five arms and look like stars. The top of a sea star's body is hard and rough.



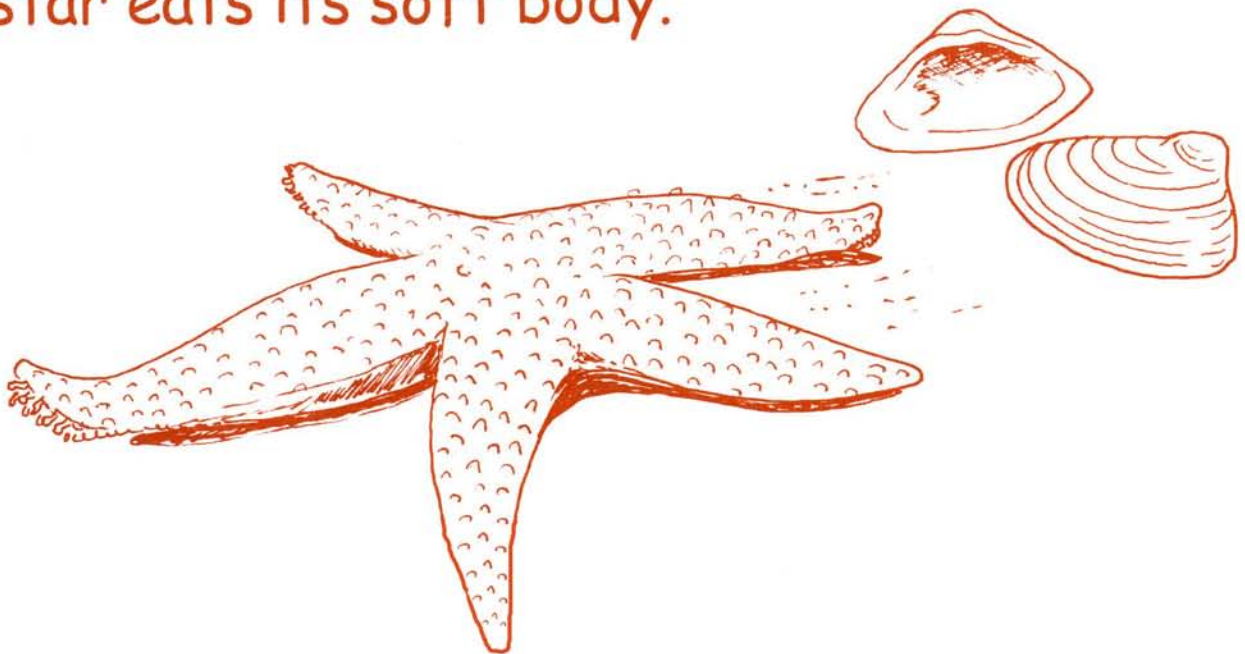
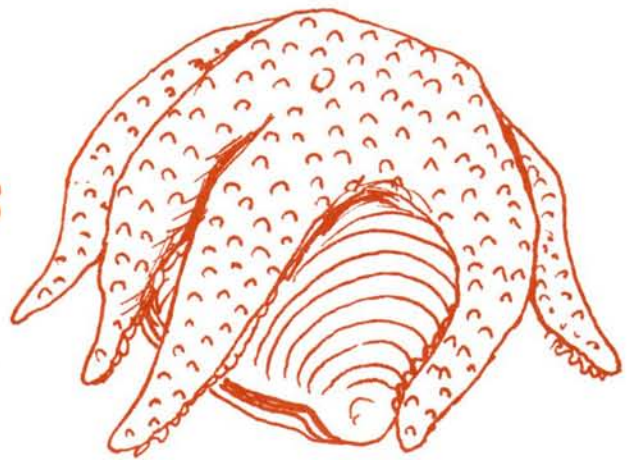
The bottom of a sea star has many tiny feet. The feet have suckers on them. These help the sea star climb and crawl.



The little animal creeps along until it finds a clam. The sea star's mouth is in the middle of its body.



The sea star climbs on top of the clam. It holds tight with its sucker feet. The sea star tugs and tugs. The clam opens up and the sea star eats its soft body.



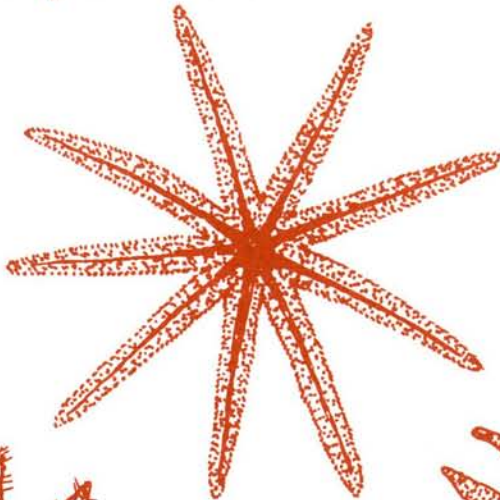
Then the sea star moves slowly away. Only the clam's shell is left behind.



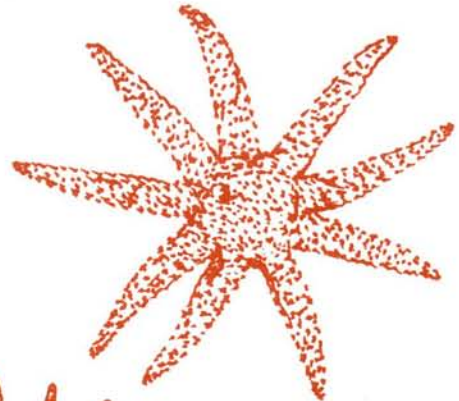
# SEA STAR MATH

Some sea stars have many more than five arms. They look like sun rays and are called SUN STARS.

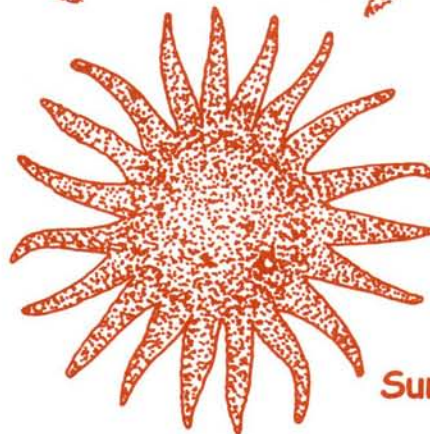
Purple sun star
