DeKalb County School District Fernbank Science Center Planetarium Admission Policies

School programs:

DeKalb: Students and teachers from schools within the DeKalb County School System will be scheduled and admitted without charge.

Groups: Students of fifteen or more from all other schools (or home-schools) who schedule as a group <u>in advance</u> will be charged \$4.00 per student. For each fifteen students one adult chaperone will be admitted without charge. All other adults beyond this number will be charged \$5.00.

Public programs:

Admission fees: Adults attending public programs will be charged \$7.00; Children, students, senior citizens (aged 62 and over) and veterans will be charged \$5.00.

Infants: Children two years of age and under (i.e. before their third birthday) are not charged admission.

Free Admission: The following receive complimentary admission:

- Fernbank Staff and their guests
- DeKalb County School District employees, upon presentation of an employee ID.
- ASTC Passport members (Click here for additional information about ATSC rules)
- Planetary Society members with proper ID
- VSA members with proper ID

Special Groups: Nonprofit organizations which serve low-income or disabled populations may receive free admission. Such groups should be asked to contact our clearing house, VSA Arts of Georgia, at 404-221-1270. VSA will then contact the Scheduler directly.

General Policies:

Readmission: Because the planetarium is totally dark at various points in the programs, admission or readmission after programs have started is difficult. The receptionist always makes a public address announcement about readmission and astronomers also make an announcement before school shows.
